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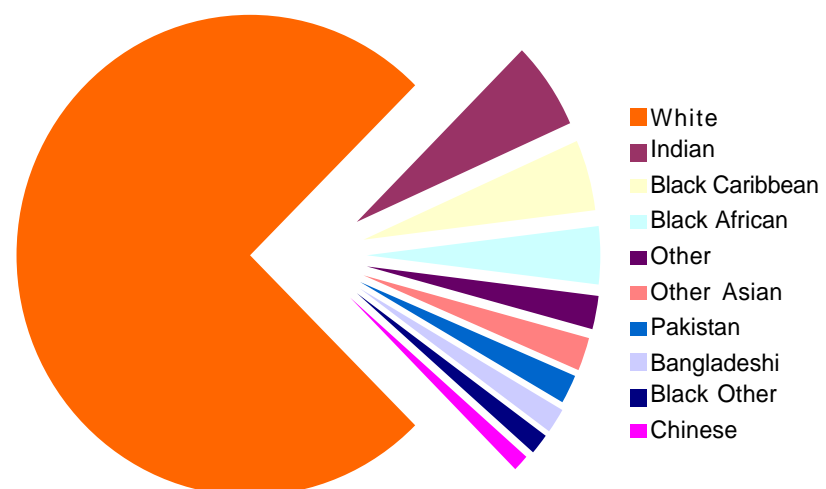
London's demography

The Department of Demographic and Statistical Studies produces estimates and projections for London's population for up to 20 years at ward and borough level, and population projections by sex, age, ethnic group, type of household and economic activity. This briefing note contains data from the department's own projections model for the main population and ethnic groups. In addition, data from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) Mid-Year Estimates for 1998, the most recent available, is shown. These government generated statistics are used by local government in areas such as calculating Standard Spending Assessments and other statutory statistical returns, planning and policy work.

The data have been aggregated from borough base data to provide a snapshot of some of the basic demographic elements of the new Greater London Assembly constituencies.

All figures in this briefing are independently rounded to the nearest 1,000.

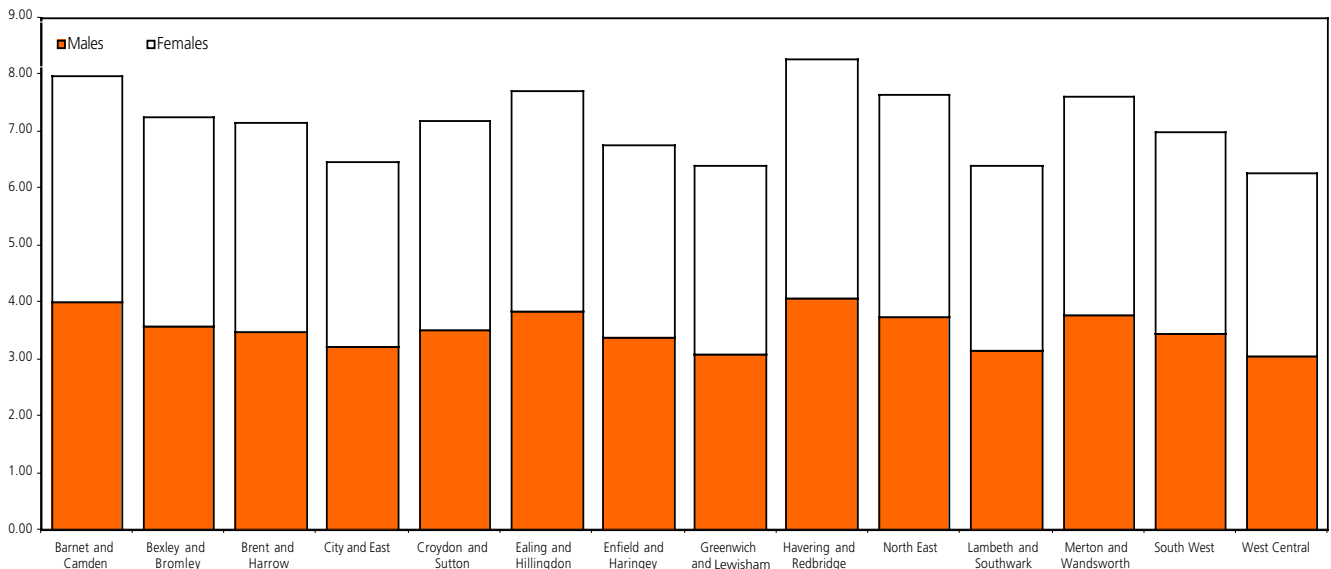
